DG Lab will host THE NEW CONTEXT CONFERENCE 2019 SAN FRANCISCO, USA on November 7, 2019. This conference is designed for people and organizations who are interested in the next business opportunities, and contexts that emerge from new technologies and inventions. This will be the twentieth conference since the first one held in Tokyo in 2005.

The focus of this year's conference will be on "Designing with Data", a translation of Data into a potential future value and experiences through Digital Designing. Rei Inamoto, founding partner of I&CO, will host the conference again this year.
